

New Jersey Association for Lifelong Learning NJALL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION 2019

Application Eligibility and Contents

- NJALL will award scholarships on June 21, 2019, to two eligible adults.

**If funding is available, a 3rd scholarship may be awarded.*

The Scholarship provides up to \$750 per semester for full-time enrollment (*pro-rated for part-time*) to a maximum of \$1,500 per year for a total of \$6,000 for higher education.

**Bonus: An additional \$500 will be awarded upon completion of the Associate's Degree and \$1,000 at completion of a Bachelor's Degree.*

Scholarship applications are open to anyone regardless of Gender, race, color, religion, age, sexual orientation or disabling condition.
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To be Eligible You Must:

1. Be a resident of New Jersey.
2. Have earned a NJ High School Diploma by attending a NJ adult education program to prepare for a High School Equivalency Exam (GED, TASC or HiSET) or to complete Adult HS requirements. (*Not limited to those who earned diplomas during this year.*)
3. Have been accepted to/or attending an accredited post-secondary institution.
4. Complete and Sign your Application.
5. Include ALL Required Documents listed below:
 - a. Copy of High School Equivalency Test scores (GED, TASC or HiSET)
**Or Copy of Adult High School Transcript.*
 - b. Copy of your High School Diploma.
 - c. Proof of acceptance to an accredited post-secondary institution
** Or Official College Transcript, if currently attending college.*
 - d. Two (2) letters of recommendation addressing your motivation, goals, ability to meet educational and life challenges and your potential for success in higher education. NOTE: *At least one letter must be attached to a completed "Educational Recommendation" form (page 4) included in the application*
6. SUBMIT the Completed Signed Application with all required supporting materials By **US Mail, postmarked** no later than: **Extended to Wednesday, May 15, 2019**

Note: *Scholarship winners are required to submit an official transcript of grades at the end of each semester as well as registration documentation at the beginning of each semester.*
